My life led to dating abusive older men, alcohol, cocaine, crack, heroin, crystal meth and self-harming. I was engaged to an abusive man who beat me while I was 2½ months pregnant. I was hospitalized and had an abortion. I fell even harder into addiction and ended up being homeless. Medication, psych wards, rehabs and counseling didn't work. I came to Teen Challenge very bitter and broken, but God has softened and healed my cold, broken heart to love others. God is restoring relationships in my family and my health. I am so thankful God has saved and healed me.
