My name is Paige Call. I am 21 years old from Sparta, Tennessee. Growing up I didn't have the privilege of a Christian home, but exactly the opposite. I began living the lifestyle of that which I was exposed to. At the young age of 12, I used methamphetamine for the first time. The next 8 years were spent hopelessly in addiction and total darkness. This led me to juvenile centers, jail time and a prison sentence. But God had better plans for me. He allowed me to come to Teen Challenge. Today I've been set free. I no longer live from high to high, but from glory to glory. Not only has Christ become my Savior, but He is Lord of my life, in whom I've been given a hope and a future. **Now the Lord is that Spirit and where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty. My name is Lindsey Johnson. I am 27 years old from Cookeville, Tennessee. I came to Teen Challenge a very broken, bitter person. I began to experiment with drugs at 16. For 10 years drugs were my life's purpose. Something that I thought I controlled actually controlled me. I became a full-blown IV user and addicted to oxycontin. After numerous charges, jail and facing 8 years in prison, God stepped in and re-directed my steps. He intervened miraculously in the courtroom, allowing me to come to Teen Challenge. Today I am becoming the woman God has intended me to be. God has done amazing restoration in my family. **God places the lonely in families; He sets the prisoner free and gives them joy.
