I was also detoxing from alcohol and feared I wouldn't make it through another detox. The night I arrived, my sisters in Christ laid hands on me at an altar, and I was supernaturally healed. I didn't suffer any of the symptoms that in the past have required medical treatment. The Lord gave me that gift, in order to keep my feet planted, so he could work miracles in my heart and mind. Since coming to TC, the Lord has delivered me from alcoholism and from the shame and guilt that kept me in bondage. I have a hope I never thought could be restored to me, and today, "The joy of the Lord is my

strength" ~ Nehemiah 8:10. I am so grateful for the vessel of Teen Challenge that has shown me God's love and taught me his Word. I know that the Lord holds my life and my future in his hands, and I plan to follow him all the days of my life.

My name is Jason. I am 41 years old, from Sydney, Australia. All my life, I have chased after the approval of the world. I knew about God, but never understood what it really meant to be a Christian man. When I was 21, I married a beautiful woman from Kalamazoo, MI and now have 4 children. God has blessed me, but desires for the world consumed me. This led me to an alcohol addiction which nearly destroyed me. I was bound by my guilt and shame. My marriage was all but over. Satan had me by the throat. I dropped to my knees one night, cried out, and the Lord spoke to me, "I've always been here


Graduate Testimonies

I exceeded in golf and hanging around country clubs, I was introduced to all kinds of sinful desires and started down the wrong path with the wrong people. What started as recreation, ended up in addiction that ruled my life. After several years of feeding my selfish desires, I hit rock bottom. Beaten and broken, I cried out to God and begged

for a way out. My prayers were answered through a great Godly man, Pastor Tim McLaughlin, who led me to Teen Challenge. My time in the program has changed

me dramatically. God has done great things in mine and my family's lives. I am excited to see what my future holds. My dad was a severe addict, and my mom received a lot of abuse by his hands, which finally resulted in divorce. Unfortunately, I followed in their footsteps of addiction and abuse and broken marriage. I was an I.V. Meth addict by the age of 28. I was also in a severely abusive marriage that nearly cost me my life. However, God intervened when I was unable. I was arrested due to my drug use and was facing multiple years in prison. It

was then that I cried out to the Lord, and He heard my cries! Since arriving at Teen Challenge last March, my family is being restored, and I have a hope for my future and a reason to live. The verse I stand on is Jonah 2:2, "I cried out to the Lord in my great trouble, and He answered me. I called to you from the land of the dead, and Lord, you heard me!"
